### Lampposts -

JB reported that within the boundary there are 100 posts all between 3-4 metres. The total cost of refurbishment would be approximately £21,000. Trafford Council will undertake maintenance prior to refurbishment. JB asked the National Trust if they could contribute towards the cost. This was declined but gave agreement to take responsibility for all railing maintenance.

The meeting approved the refurbishment of lampposts in Dunham Town as a pilot prior to roll-out across Dunham Massey.

New Action: JB to ask JRM to confirm the Trust's decision to maintain all the railings going forwards

New Action: JB to contact the contractor to arrange for the refurbishment of the Dunham Town lampposts

## <u>Underbridge Wooden Beam -</u>

Peel agreed to make good the underbridge and erect a beam by the end of the month. Works require the road to be closed giving Amey the opportunity to take down trees and clear out the drains. Trafford Council will update bridge signage.

#### Road repairs -

New Action: DJ will ask Trafford Council for a schedule of road servicing works

New Action: DJ and CR to measure and plot the potholes in Charcoal Road

#### Bus shelter -

The Parish Clerk notified Councillors that the National Trust were unable to provide a specification and cost for a bus shelter. Action Complete.

New Action: Parish Clerk to ask for companies to quote for a wooden bus shelter, with seat but no sides or glass

#### Kings Coronation –

The meeting agreed to include a plaque on the proposed village signs commemorating the Coronation rather than provide residents with a pin badge. The design was approved following inclusion of the Coronation date. Action Complete

New Action: CR to send the Parish Clerk an electric copy of the Coronation Design

RA provided the Parish Clerk with names of companies who make ornamental signs suitable for the Memorial Garden and Paddock Lane. KW has emailed asking for quotes.
