Lampposts -

Work has begun on the first phase of the lamppost refurbishment. Thanks given to the contractors. Possibility of replacing tops with LED.

Road repairs potholes -

DJ raised the issue again directly with Amey (Trafford Partnership team). The online portal shows 9 separate instances of reports of potholes by different people including DJ. The service request has been rejected "When investigated, the problem you reported did not require action as it does not meet our criteria". In response DJ has written directly to Trafford asking them to explain what the criteria is that they have used.

Unless a pothole is more than 50mm deep Trafford will not act. They are not part of Fix My Highway.

The issue of potholes has been raised many times recently on Dunham Life and demonstrates the frustration of Dunham Massey residents about the poor state of the roads locally.

MW said that a section of Charcoal Road was going to be repaired along with a section of road near the Rope and Anchor.
